Key Points

Surge in VC-backed court reporting agencies. Smaller agencies acquired due to aging owners, reporter shortages, and tech changes. Industry concerns about stenographer shortages.

CSR vs. Digital Deposition Officer

Risks to litigant/consumer protection due to insurance and investment influence.

Court Reporter Shortage

Developing since 1990, widening due to reduced schools and enrollment. 2021 exam stats: 175 students, 36 passed. 71% of California trial courts recruiting reporters.

Risks of Digital Reporting

Digital Reporters lack shorthand skills and can't testify.

No state-required training or certification for machine operators; no reporting requirements if fired for misconduct.
